Thank you for your letter of 21 September on behalf of your constituents regarding vehicles speeding through the village of Dolwyddelan on the A470.

We are currently in the process of carrying out a three year Speed Limit Review, looking at road safety issues at over 600 sites on all trunk roads in Wales. Your constituent's comments regarding speeding in Dolwyddelan will be taken on board as part of this process when this section of the A470 is reviewed. The results of the review will be made available online and any works arising from the wider review will be prioritised, as funding allows for a programmed completion over the next three to four years.

Regarding your comments about vehicles parking on the side of the road and obstructing the flow of traffic through the village, this is an enforcement issue for North Wales Police. Vehicles can be removed from the highway and their owners can be prosecuted.

Go Safe, the Road Safety Partnership are responsible for speed limit enforcement. Your constituents may wish to highlight their concerns regarding traffic speeds directly, via the following webpage: <https://gosafe.org/contact-us/community-concern/>.
